



Bursary for student study / exchange in Estonia

Application Guidelines 2019

The scholarship recipients will be chosen by a panel (“Panel”) from the Board of Directors and staff of the Estonian (Toronto) Credit Union Limited (“ECU”) to recognize young members who are looking for a study / exchange opportunity in Estonia in their specific specialty, including vocational education areas.

The Panel retains discretion to determine the number of Scholarships to be awarded. The Panel reserves the right to award no Scholarships.

In awarding Scholarships, the Panel will place greater emphasis on:

- i) the applicants’ involvement in the Estonian community
- ii) the outlined objective of the study or exchange

Applications may be in English or Estonian, but submissions in Estonian are appreciated.

To be considered for a Scholarship, the applicant must:

1. be an ECU member;
2. not have previously received this same scholarship from ECU;
3. submit a CV;
4. submit a statement about the study or exchange for which they are travelling to Estonia for; what is the field of study, reasons why they want to attend and for how long they will be going. In the statement, he or she must tell us if and how they think their experience will help our local community in Canada, either now or in the future;
5. submit a letter of reference from someone in the Estonian community;
6. on receipt of the Scholarship, the applicant must agree to submit two overviews along with photos of their experience. One would be submitted during their trip, and the other after they have returned from Estonia. How was their experience, what did they learn? Have their views changed on how their experience could help our local community?
7. agree that his or her name, photo, biography, testimonial and written discussions may be published by ECU in its promotional materials.
